Program Description:

The 120-hour (three-week) field-based Forestry Field Skills program (FoFS) trains individuals in three key forestry areas of demand and employment: Safety and the Environment, Silviculture, & Wildfire Management and Control.

*Each NRTG course includes free, lifetime admission.
Enrol once - come back anytime.*

In addition to a 'Forestry Field Skills' certificate, course graduates will also receive individual certificates in:

- S-100 Basic Fire Suppression and Safety
- ICS 100 Incident Command
- S-212 Communications

Objectives

Upon successful completion, FoFS participants will be qualified and able to:

- Identify key wilderness awareness strategies and procedures
- Conduct basic Forestry measurements, assessments and field procedures
- Conduct Forestry surveying and field mapping
- Identify and apply standard silviculture, stand tending & fuel management field procedures
- Conduct field work as a recognized "Qualified Persons" field technician
- Operate and maintain a chainsaw, brush saw, water pump and winch
- Work safely and responsibly in the forestry workplace
- Identify the key phases and management of Wildfires
- Conduct Fire Suppression & Safety procedures as a qualified S-100 Wildland Firefighter
- Understand the roles and responsibilities with the Incident Command System
- Conduct standard field communication protocols and procedures

Course Format:

The 120-hour (three-week) Forestry Field Skills Program is delivered weekdays over three consecutive weeks. The FoFS delivery 'season' will vary by region, as the program requires suitable field conditions (unfrozen soils, no snow cover, 'ideally' with intact vegetation, etc.).

Personal Equipment Requirements:

Course participants are required to provide their own personal protective equipment: suitable field clothing (including rain gear), hardhat with muffs and face screen, field vest, shovel, compass and GPS unit.
